The cereal crop agronomy module will be an interactive 2-day session. It is suited to those who are at the start of their agronomy career and are members of AICCA.

The module will explore key agronomic decisions which have an influence on the yield, quality and profitability of cereal crops whilst giving due regard to protection of the environment. The key focus will be to look at wheat, barley and oats but reference will also be made to triticale and rye. The module will cover the following: Markets, specification and variety choice. Cereal crop establishment including cultivation methods, seed rate, sowing date, certified vs. farm saved seed, seed treatments. Crop physiology, growth stages and crop nutrition. Integrated management of weeds, pests, diseases and lodging. Harvest management and crop storage.
